Anti-corruption clause

Applicable to corruption in general with emphasis on bribery

FOR LEGAL ENTITIES AND INDIVIDUALS

The contracting parties undertake to take every measure so that neither they nor any of their employees or representatives commit any form of corrupt conduct, especially conduct that could be perceived as receiving or giving bribes or indirect bribery or another crime connected with corruption according to the Act No. 40/2009 Coll., the Criminal Code, as amended.

The contracting parties undertake not to give, offer or promise a bribe to or for another person in connection with the procurement of things in the public interest or in connection with business activities of their own or another person. The contracting parties also undertake not to accept a bribe or a promise of a bribe for themselves or for another person in connection with the procurement of things in the public interest or in connection with business activities of their own or another person. In this context, a bribe means an undue advantage consisting of an immediate financial enrichment or another benefit that is received or is to be received by the bribed person or, with this person's consent, by another person without any entitlement.

The contracting parties will not tolerate any form of corruption or bribery even in their business partners.
